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Made in a Burgundian style, the 2005 Agapans (100% old vine Grenache aged in both new and old small barrels) exhibits notes of forest floor, sweet kirsch, and black fruits. The most expensive wine of Costieres de Nimes, it is incredibly aromatic, pure, and medium-bodied with tremendous precision as well as minerality. It should drink nicely for 4-5 years.

A Proprietary Blend Dry Red Table wine from Costieres de Nimes, Languedoc Roussillon, France

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This impressive duo includes the 2006 Perrottes, a blend of 70% Syrah and 30% Grenache, half aged in concrete tanks and half in both used and new small barrels. It is an elegant, stylish, dark ruby/purple-colored effort displaying complex aromatics of red and blackberries, licorice, lavender, and a touch of Provencal herbs. Lush and medium-bodied with a layered mouthfeel and silky tannins, it should drink nicely for 4-5 years.

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
